Invasive Exotic Plants

Severe threat to habitat and natural areas:

- Tree of heaven (*Ailanthus altissima*) – China
- Mimosa (*Albizia julibrissin*) – Asia
- Asian bittersweet (*Celastrus orbiculatus*) – Asia
- Autumn olive (*Elaeagnus umbellata*) – China/Japan
- English ivy (*Hedera helix*) – Europe
- Chinese privet (*Ligustrum sinense*) – China/Europe
- Japanese honeysuckle (*Lonicera japonica*) – East Asia
- Princess tree (*Paulownia tomentosa*) – East Asia
- Kudzu (*Pueraria montana*) – China/Japan
- Multiflora rose (*Rosa multiflora*) – Japan
- Chinese wisteria (*Wisteria sinensis*) – Asia

Significant threat to native communities:

- Japanese barberry (*Berberis thunbergii*)
- Burning bush (*Euonymus alata*)
- Japanese privet (*Ligustrum japonicum*)
- Oregon grape (*Mahonia bealei*)
- Chinese silver grass (*Miscanthus sinensis*)
- Nandina (*Nandina domestica*)
- Bradford pear (*Pyrus calleryana*)
- Common periwinkle (*Vinca minor*)
- Japanese wisteria (*Wisteria floribunda*)
